

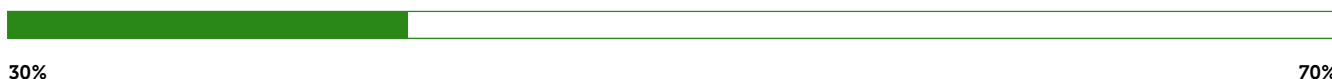

The Course

This level one course is a Level 1 Diploma in Vocational Studies, with specialist units in Childcare and Health included. You will study core employability units where you will gain key, transferable skills with other learners studying level one programmes in the general further education department. You will also be able to specialise in Childcare and Health, giving you the specialist skills and knowledge needed to progress to Level 2. The course recognises the importance of developing core skills through practical, creative activities, along with beginning to build your industry relevant skills.

You will need GCSEs at grade 1 or 2, including English and Maths, a passion for the subject and one satisfactory reference.

Time Required on Campus

You will normally be in college three days a week.

Work Experience

You will need to undertake 30 hours of work experience.

How You're Assessed

You will be assessed through assignments and practical tasks.

If you wish to further your studies you can progress to a Level 2 course in Health and Social Care or Childcare.
