### **TASK 1 –**

Fold and photograph a mask in varying positions over a figure to design a range of garments.

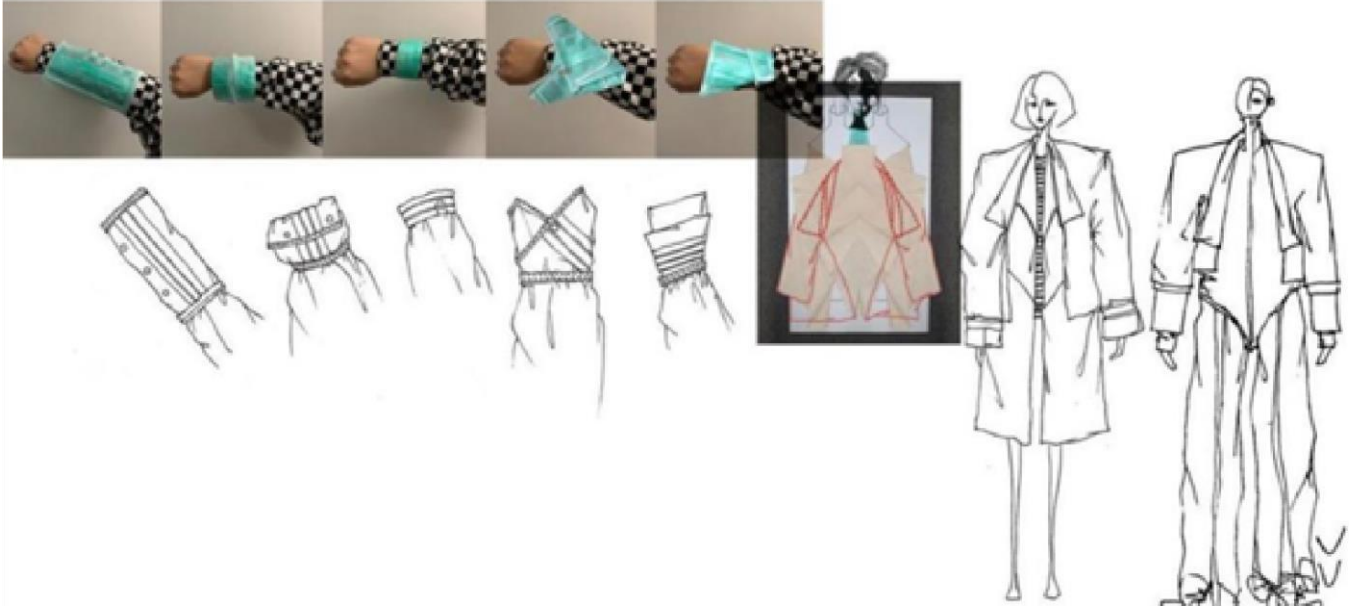
Photograph these or scan them in. Create a document with all the photographed designs in.



## TASK 2 -

Use the mask and imagine it as garment details. They could be pockets, collars, lapels, hemlines etc. You could use multiple ones to maximize the use of its pleats. Photograph them attached to a wearer or your own garments to create garment details. Once photographed draw your results into a range of designs using the ideas generated.
