Class 1 – Intro B (2008) Warm Up /Non- Qualifier

Class 2 – Prelim 7 (2002) Warm Up /Non- Qualifier

Class 3 - Prelim 13 (2006) Team & Individual Qualifier

Class 4 – Novice 24 (2010) Warm Up /Non- Qualifier

Class 5 Novice 28 (2008) Team & Individual Qualifier

Class 6 Elementary 50 (2007) Individual Qualifier Only

Entry Fee £18 per test

Teams - Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count. Up to two riders to compete in the prelim test and up to two riders in the novice test. All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules')

Grassroots SJ / Combined Training

Classes 7 – 11 NSEA Grass Roots Rules apply

Class 7 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted) Judged on style. Not timed

Class 8 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted) Single phase

Class 9 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Class 10 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Class 11 Grass Roots Mixed Height Teams 40, 50, 60, 70. (One rider per height.) **TO ENTER** – please enter your individuals in classes 1-4, then do an entry for class 5 (no charge) and identify the team members in the comments.

Entry Fee (Class 7-11) - £22 per Class.

Combined Training

Class 12 – To enter as combined training, enter the dressage test you would like (Class 1,2 or 4), and select put in your preferred jumping height in the notes for your entry.

Entry Fee (Class 12) - £8 per Class.
