Getting the Bus to Bishop Burton College

Many of our students travel from home to college on a daily basis using our bus service.

- If you live on one of our existing bus routes, transport to and from college may be FREE
- If you can use public transport to meet our existing bus routes, we will reimburse the costs e.g., public bus services or train services
- If a public service route is the only means of travelling to college, we will reimburse the costs.

Whatever your transport dilemma we will endeavour to help you where possible with the costs of attending college. If you are not eligible for free transport, you can still use the bus service by buying a bus token. Bus route tokens can be purchased from Student Services or online at the Bishop Burton Shop. The bus token price is £2.50 per journey.

PLEASE NOTE: You MUST stick your arm out to stop the bus.

Bus Passes

To access your free bus pass, you need to download the EY Buses App to your device and register for an account, you can use your personal email address for this. Once you have enrolled and received your Bishop Burton email address, we will sent your annual ticket via an email and Gift Code. Simply apply the gift code to your EY Bus App and activate it. You then just scan the QR code on your app to access the college bus.

Behaviour on College Buses

Students will be expected to behave appropriately at all times when travelling on the free college transport, this includes whilst waiting within the college bus terminal. CCTV is in operation on all our bus routes, this is for the safety of all our students and for the protection of the driver.

Anyone found to demonstrate a lack of respect towards fellow students, staff or members of the public, may be subject to disciplinary procedures that could forfeit the right to travel on college buses.

Free Bus Routes

We operate 13 routes across the region, with all services running from Monday to Friday during term time only.

Inward journey times are shown on the following pages, with all buses departing Bishop Burton College from the main bus terminal for their return journeys at 17.15pm.

All timings are approximate and you are advised to be at your pick-up point at least 10 minutes before the time stated. If you miss your bus, you MUST make your own travel arrangements to the college.

Parking at Bishop Burton College

Students can park free of charge at any time at the college. However, you will need to apply for a parking permit. You can apply in advance by completing the application form on our website. You'll find it at **www.bishopburton.ac.uk/parking**

There is one main car park for students and this can be accessed via the main entrance on the A1079. The car park is close to student accommodation and includes disabled parking bays and drop-off points.

The college aims to provide students with car parking facilities that are safe, secure and convenient. For the safety of everyone on site, all persons must obey traffic signs, speed limits and follow any instructions from staff.

The college operates a barrier system, which can be operated using your student ID card. However, all vehicles must be registered beforehand. The college does not accept responsibility for any loss, damage, or misfortune to vehicles, motorcycles, scooters or bicycles (or their contents) brought onto or parked on college property.

Accommodation

If you don't think travelling in everyday will work for you, don't worry! We have accommodation on site for both further education and higher education students.
