Getting the bus to Bishop Burton College

Many of our students travel from home to college on a daily basis using our bus service.

- If you live on one of our existing bus routes, transport to and from college may be FREE
- If you can use public transport to meet our existing bus routes, we will reimburse the costs e.g. public bus services or train services
- If a public service route is the only means of travelling to college, we will reimburse the costs.

Whatever your transport dilemma we will endeavour to help you where possible with the costs of attending college. If you are not eligible for free transport, you can still use the bus service by buying a bus token. Bus route tokens can be purchased from Student Services or online at the Bishop Burton Shop. The bus token price is £1.50 per journey.

PLEASE NOTE: You MUST stick your arm out to stop the bus.

College Bus Routes

The following bus routes indicate the main bus stops along the route and give an indication of the time it should arrive at each stop, if you live along a particular route, you may be able to use an alternative bus stop along the route, please contact transport@bishopburton.ac.uk for clarification or any other transport related questions you may have.

Free Bus Routes

We operate 13 routes across the region, with all services running from Monday to Friday during term time only.

Inward journey times are shown on the following pages, with all buses departing Bishop Burton College from the main bus terminal for their return journeys at 1715 (Mon-Thu) and 1645 on Fridays.

All timings are approximate and you are advised to be at your pick-up point at least 10 minutes before the time stated. If you miss your bus, you **MUST** make your own travel arrangements to the college.

Bus Passes

All students must submit an application for transport funding via the PayMyStudent Portal as part of their enrolment, you will also need to download the free East Yorkshire Buses app and register for a Bishop Burton digital bus pass/ticket. After your bus pass request has been verified, you will receive a gift code that can be redeemed in the app for your mobile ticket. You must scan your mobile ticket each time you travel.

Behaviour on college buses

Parking at Bishop Burton College

Students can park free of charge at any time at the college. However, you will need to apply for a parking permit from Student Services. You can apply in advance by completing the application form on our website. You'll find it at [Car Parking Permit Application Form | Bishop Burton College](#)

There is one main car park for students and this can be accessed via the main entrance on the A1079. The car park is close to student accommodation and includes disabled parking bays and drop-off points.

The college aims to provide students with car parking facilities that are safe, secure and convenient. For the safety of everyone on site, all persons must obey traffic signs, speed limits and follow any instructions from staff.

The college operates a barrier system, which can be operated using your studentID card. However, all vehicles must be registered beforehand. The college does not accept responsibility for any loss, damage, or misfortune to vehicles, motorcycles, scooters or bicycles (or their contents) brought onto or parked on college property.

Accommodation

If you don't think travelling in everyday will work for you, don't worry! We have accommodation on site for both further education and higher education students.

Further education students with a household income of less than £50,000 could be eligible for a residential bursary to help cover the costs of accommodation too.
